Traveling I-91 North or South – Merge onto I-84 West heading toward Waterbury, exit 39 (Route 4, Farmington). Head straight off the exit and travel West on Route 4 for 2.2 miles. Turn right onto Devonwood Drive and then turn left onto Winding Trails Drive.

Traveling from Interstate 84, exit 39 (Route 4, Farmington). Head straight off the exit and travel West on Route 4 for 2.2 miles. Turn right onto Devonwood Drive and then turn left onto Winding Trails Drive.

Registration:

Register online at www.bikereg.com or send 2007 standard entry form and check made payable to Benidorm Bikes, to Benidorm Bikes, P.O. Box 40, Canton, CT 06019, ATTN: Chainbiter 9.0. A \$5 Day-of fee applies to any entries received after 5pm on Nov. 1 or on the day of the event. Registration opens at 7:30am and closes 1 hour before each event. No refunds for pre-registered riders.

Collegiate/NCCA riders may enter their appropriate category, but must note which school they represent as their team name, race in their NCCA jersey, and show an active NCCA license at registration.

Regulations:

USA Cycling has implemented a category system for cyclo-cross. Masters can only ride in either the Cat 1/2/3 race or the Cat 3/4 race – not both. Riders registered for the Cat 3/4 Masters race will not be allowed to race in the Cat 1/2/3 Masters race. Elite Men, Elite Women, and U23 must have a UCI license and use UCI legal cross bikes. Mountain bikes accepted in all other classes. International licenses will be available on race day. Bring a passport or birth certificate. Helmets must be worn in all races. No bar ends, aero bars or sleeveless jerseys allowed. U15 Juniors (10-14) will be placed at the completion of 2 laps. They may continue on for the 40 minute U19 Junior race, and will receive placings in both the U15 race and the U19 race if they complete the distance.

The rider's contribution to the Council for the Fight Against Doping (CFAD) of 2% is included in the Prize Money.
